



- BEST SOLUTION: Cafe standards (best of very bad options)



My Theory Taxes Causes Obesity










Is Africa Ideal? Calorific consumption not monotonic! Similar to automobile speed, gas mileage ...




Obesity Up, not Overweight



Reasons for Obesity


- *Big Two* explanations (Manufacturing & Marketing)
- reduced physical activity (reduced school-based physical education)
- increased availability of fast-food
- less sleep
- Ambient Temperature Decreases (air-conditioning breakdown, restaurant sales drop)
- southern US -- highest obesity rates, air conditioning increased from 37% to 70%
- Decreased Smoking (Nicotine has both thermogenic and appetite suppressant)
- Pharmaceutical latrogenesis (e.g.,psychotropic medications dramatic increase)
- Changes in Distribution of Ethnicity and Age (Marked Differences between European-Americans)
- Increasing Gravida Age (older mother loss of brown adipose)
- Intrauterine and Intergenerational Effects (maternal obesity & diabetes)
- reproductive yielding selection for obesity-predisposing genotypes
- assortative mating and floor effects





A rational reconstruction of the compromise effect

- Bad Decision
- Suppose with Full Information
- Chooses B from {A, B, C}
- How can we help the consumer by forcing another choice when B is the fullinformation choice... by definition everyone is worse-off
- Need a theory for why we help the decision-maker by decreasing their utility

Mandated Gas mileage – Unintended Consequences

- Drive More (raised fixed cost, lower variables cost) Save Gas?? Money??
- Lighter Cars Less Safe (MDX)
- More pollutants
- Higher Prices Keep Older Cars on Road
- Lower Income People hurt Most
- Simply has not worked if reduced gasoline consumption is the goal

Unintended Consequences

- Free Refills (already everywhere in Florida except Wendy's)
- Can detach soft-drinks (unlike gas engines)
- Shift to diet additives
- Justifies Deceptive Practices (more ice, mislabel container)
- No profit in Decreased Context Demand
- Only profitable to raise price
